# **How to test for Fentanyl**

#### Lower Your Risk of Overdose

#### **Be Careful**

- Go slow by taking smaller amounts
- Use with people you trust and inject at different times
- Have Naloxone available and know how to use it



## Step 1: Testing Cooker Residue

## **Prepare Shot**

- Prepare your shot as normal and set aside the needle to test your substance left over in the cooker before injection
- Add enough water to fill your cooker.
  Stir if necessary



### Step 2: Testing

## **Use the Test Strip**


- Place the test strip wavy side down in the water for 15s. Make sure the water is up to the line
- Remove strip from water and place it on a flat surface for 1-2 minutes




## Step 3: Results

#### **Read the Results**

- A test POSITIVE for fentanyl is indicated by ONE RED LINE
- A test NEGATIVE for fentanyl is indicated by TWO RED LINES



Remember, no test is 100% accurate,
 & a negative test does not necessarily
 mean you are safe



NOTE: It should be considered a NEGATIVE test even if a second red line is faded or faint If possible, use an additional test to confirm your results
