

## **LIMA Diversion Program Benchmarks**

### **(Days 1 – 45)**

- Complete Release of Information & LIMA Agreement Form
- Obtain Vital Records
- Enroll in treatment services
- Apply for insurance
- Apply for Veterans benefits
- Apply for SNAP benefits
- Remain abstinent from substance use

### **(Days 45 – 90)**

- Complete Job Search
- Open Savings Account
- Enroll in Educational courses or Life Skill classes
- Enroll in Job Training and/or Job Readiness classes
- Family Support / Make connections
- Attend Self-Help Groups
- Search for independent housing

### **(Days 90 – 120)**

- Move into independent housing (around 90 days clients should be ready to move off of grant funding housing)
- Close any pending legal issues
- Completed a level of care in treatment

### **(Days 120 – 12 months)**

- Continue progress towards treatment goals and personal goals
- Staff overall progress to determine graduation



### **Overview**

- We expect a willingness to be honest and have integrity
- LIMA Team members
  - LVMPD Officers
  - Coordinator
  - Case management
  - Sober living
- If applicable – Remain compliant with Probation requirements
- Encouraged to attend recovery support meetings
- Submit medical documentation / Prescriptions to case managers [coordinator(s) if necessary]
- Employment / Group Schedule Changes; must provide proof to provider & coordinator
- Follow up and address pending warrants and other legal issues
- Travel; need to be staffed for approval
- All cases are dealt with on an **individual basis**

Clients are expected to remain compliant with provider guidelines, meet the expectations of the LIMA Program, including remaining abstinent from all substances (relapses will be handled on an individual basis)
